



Virtual Curriculum Review Series

Professional Development Proposal

SERVICES AND INTENDED OUTCOMES

Virtual 3 Session Bundle: \$2,500 (value \$3,550)

- 3 virtual professional development sessions (2 hours each) with Q&A immediately after each virtual session
- Planning call to discuss goals and timeline for sessions with leadership
- Up to 2 consultative conversations (to be used within 6 months of the first session)
- Debrief call after completion of the bundle to discuss progress and next steps with leadership

Intended Outcomes for the Series:

- Build your team's capacity to choose a topic and develop focus questions for review
- Apply the steps in a review cycle to gain insight into curriculum and create a plan for actionable improvement
- Gain hands-on experience investigating the curriculum in order to inform decisions

Overview

As a team, decide on which topics and questions your team will use during each review. These sessions will be structured as both an introduction to the steps in a review cycle and as hands on experience in completing a cycle with a specific focus. Each session will follow a similar format based on the focus of review. Participants should come prepared to engage in facilitated work time and collaborative conversations.

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- Leadership Planning
 - Call to discuss the overall curriculum review goals
 - Submit topic(s) and focus question(s) prior to the first session
 - Sessions 1 and 2: Guided Curriculum Review 1 & 2
 - Explore and discuss the 5 steps of a review cycle with examples
 - Identify data sources to apply to review
 - With guidance and support, narrow your topic and begin this review cycle using your own school's information
 - *When applicable, learn to fully utilize reports in Atlas*
 - *If needed, choose and customize appropriate rubrics*
 - Submit prior to Session 3: As a team, complete an independent review cycle
 - Session 3: Guided Curriculum Review 3
 - Collaboratively discuss findings from the third review
 - Reflect on the overall process of using the cycles to review the curriculum
 - Consider additional needs to ensure the ongoing use of the curriculum review cycles to update and strengthen the written curriculum
